- of Grouseland"), without regard to the statute of
- limitations, including section 2501 of title 28,
- United States Code, and any delay-based defense, no
- matter how characterized.
- 15 (2) Jurisdiction expiration.—Not later
- than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act,
- the jurisdiction conferred to the United States Court
- of Federal Claims under paragraph (1) shall expire
- unless the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma files a land
- claim under that paragraph.
- 21 (b) Extinguishment of Title and Claims.—Ex-
- 22 cept for a claim filed under subsection (a)(1), all other
- 23 claims, including any and all future claims, of the

- 1 Miami Tribe of Oklahoma, or any member, descendant,
- 2 or predecessor in interest to the Miami Tribe of Okla-
