1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Temporary Extension
5 of Fentanyl-Related Substances Scheduling Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY ORDER FOR**
7 **FENTANYL-RELATED SUBSTANCES.**

8 Section 2 of the Temporary Reauthorization and
9 Study of the Emergency Scheduling of Fentanyl Ana-
10 logues Act (Public Law 116–114; 134 Stat. 103) is

1 amended by striking “March 31, 2025” and inserting
2 “September 30, 2025”.

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
