In 2001, she was elected to the San Bernardino City Unified Board of Education, a position she remained in for 10 years.

The legislation introduced by my friend and colleague, Mr. AGUILAR, would rename the Del Rosa Post Office to honor Dr. Hill, a beloved educator and longtime advocate for the people of San Bernardino.

I was honored to know her and work with her, and this will ensure that future generations will recognize and appreciate the impact that Dr. Hill had on our community.

Madam Speaker, I urge adoption of this bill.
