PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF H.R. 8070, SERVICEMEMBER QUALITY OF LIFE IMPROVEMENT AND NATIONAL DEFENSE AU- THORIZATION ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; RELATING TO CON- SIDERATION OF HOUSE REPORT 118-527 AND ACCOMPANYING RES- OLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PUR- POSES
